- Decide on a Legal Structure:

 - LLC

 - C-Corporation
 - -Importance of Operating Agreements

- Determine if you need a Data Universal Number System (DUNS) Number
 - Plan to seek Government contracts
 - Plan to seek Government grants
 - Plan to seek Government loans

- Make sure you have all licenses and permits needed
 - Check with your local (city, county) authorities regarding any zoning regulations-each community establishes their own regulations.

- Start off with the right Financial Information
 - Consult an accountant or bookkeeper to set your books up correctly from the beginning!
 - It will save money by avoiding late fees and penalties (and STRESS)

- Determine your Insurance Needs
 - Liability
 - Property
 - Key person
 - Worker's Compensation
 - Unemployment
